Jelly Bean Dance Notice



Dear Jelly Bean Dance Participants,

MOCA would like to explain a few measures we take to keep the Jelly Bean Dances operating.

General Rules at the Jelly Bean Dance:

- No running- for the safety of all
- No Gum- to help keep the facility & equipment presentable
- No outside food or drink- we have a concession at reasonable rates
- Ages 6-12 yrs.: This dance is designed for 6-12 years only. Any younger could get hurt. We are continually working with youth groups & other sources to design a dance for teens. *This event is not for teens.* If 16 yrs. plus would like to attend, they can do so by signing up as a youth volunteer - contact rentals@millicanogdencommunity.com for more information.

Things to know:

Tickets:

NOTE: Beginning Feb 2017, Jelly Bean Dance tickets will only be available at the MOCA main office prior to the dance. Tickets will go on sale 1st of the Month prior to the event up to 3 days before the dance. This will help:

- ❖ To speed the line (no one standing out in the unpredictable weather). As well as to eliminate having to turn away anyone at the door when we reach our maximum capacity.
- ❖ Ensure we purchase enough supplies
- ❖ Ensure we have enough volunteers signed up prior to the dance

Doors open at 6:45pm but the dance officially starts at 7pm. Door will remain open until 7:30pm. We then lock the doors and no child is allowed out until the end of the dance at 9pm. This is also to ensure your child remains safe.

- ❖ MOCA members- show your card to receive \$1 off per ticket
- ❖ *Tickets will NOT be available at the door
- ❖ **Tickets can be purchased online via Paypal, at the MOCA office M-F 1-4 PM, or over the phone with a credit card (if unable to come into the office)
- ❖ In the event MOCA cancels the dance, you will be given the option of ticket refund or to use at the next scheduled dance (not any other; notifications will be sent). Otherwise, there are no refunds or carry overs.

Safety:

MOCA takes safety seriously. MOCA requires parents to enter emergency contact information at the time of ticket purchase just in case something should occur we know who to contact. Also, parents are asked to come in with their child to "sign them in" this is for us to know they are in attendance & for you to meet who your child is being left with for 2 hours. All Volunteers are also orientated and sign a safety acknowledgement form each dance.

Our capacity:

Our hall has a maximum capacity of 150 when food & beverage is at an event. We have 10 - 20 volunteers that monitor the children. Leaving 130 spots for tickets to be sold. By purchasing your tickets prior you will know if capacity has been capped.

Volunteering:

If you would like to stay with your child (6-12 yrs.) during the dance, please consider becoming a volunteer for the Jelly Bean Dance.

This help MOCA to:

- ❖ Keep track of who is in the building in case of emergency,
- ❖ Helps accumulate volunteer hours for grants as well as for yourself,
- ❖ Helps ensure your child is safe
- ❖ Helps keep a wonderful community tradition alive.
