
A MESSAGE FROM THE VICE PRESIDENT



HISTORY OF MILLICAN-OGDEN

LYNNWOOD TRAFFIC SAFETY PROJECT

After ongoing advocacy by community members and MOCA, the City of Calgary will be undertaking a traffic safety project along both 18 St SE and 66 Ave SE.

Several key intersections and crosswalks will have temporary traffic calming curbs installed. These curbs are the same large yellow curbs installed at the southeast corner of the intersection of 76 Ave SE and 18 St SE. The curbs will shorten crossing distances for pedestrians as well as narrow the road so as to keep vehicles within the speed limit.

This much-needed project is an important step to increase safety around Banting & Best and Sherwood schools, which see many children walking and wheeling.

The design and exact locations are being finalized and will be shared when available by MOCA through our channels. The City plans to install the curbs over the May long weekend (May 20-22). Later on this summer, the curbs and their locations will be "spruced up" with paint, planters, and other features to increase vibrancy. Watch for more information on that too.

As a reminder, nearly all of the streets in our community have an unposted speed limit of 40 km/h and there are many playground zones which have a speed limit of 30 km/h between 7:30am and 9:00pm. Please visit the City of Calgary map for speed limit information on specific streets:

SPRING CLEANING TIPS


